The Jesus Storybook Bible (Sally Lloyd-Jones)	A selection of bible stories, told simply and beautifully, which highlights God's love and Jesus' rescue plan through every story.	Aimed at younger kids, but all ages will enjoy it adults will learn as much as the children! The Action Bible and Action Bible Devotional (Jeremy V Jones)	The bible told through comic-style story-telling. Features 215 bible stories in chronological order. The devotional has a story and questions/reflections etc for each week of the year in the same comic style.	Older children, 10+.	Eden, Amazon, The Good Book Store etc.	This bible is perfect if your child likes action cartoons, and finds it easier to look at pictures rather than read. The reflections, missions and questions in the devotional are perfectly pitched and it's a great alternative to a 'normal' bible.
The Hands On Bible	A children's bible, packed with pictures, activities, questions, explanations, facts and studies.	Children aged 8-11, available in blue, pink or multi- coloured.	Eden, Amazon, The Good Book Store etc.	This is the kind of bible that makes your children want to read it more, and the personalisation and activities within means it can really be special to your son or daughter.
Topz Magazines (CWR)	This bimonthly devotional helps children get to know God and His Word through an exciting day-by-day look at the Bible. There's daily bible readings and simple prayers along with fun and colourful word games, puzzles and cartoons. The daily readings are perfectly aimed at 7-11 year olds and makes reading the bible fun, engaging, and relevant.
