Volunteer Role

Main responsibilities:

- Inspire a growing passion within the congregations for God's wider work in the world as an overflow of the Kingdom.
- Facilitate wider congregation engagement with the partners and their work.
- Manage communication with members of the congregation who oversee our Partners.

Role Description:

God fills us with his Spirit to overflowing (collectively and individually) - our partnerships are an expression of this collective overflow. The generous, effervescent Spirit of God is giving birth to new mission and project work, it also cultivates and brings existing work to maturity. Father is joyfully and creatively at work in our communities, in the wider UK church and in the rest of the world. This role exists to foster an environment in which we can gladly join in, individually and collectively, to the extent that God inspires us.

Skills and attributes:

- Relational – seeks out and builds on the common ground between groups with differing objectives
- Excellent communication skills
- Mature faith to hold some responsibility and recognise sensitivities
- Able to fulfil simple administrative tasks (email or letter communication and simple spreadsheet)

Detailed Responsibilities:

- Liaising with our partners and building some direct relationships with actual projects.
- Coordinating a streamlined communication to the congregation about our giving partners.
- Ensuring the website and notice board are updated.
- Attend quarterly 'Giving Team' meetings.
- Arrange Partner relationships team meetings at least twice per year.
